## **Climate Change Questions (extra credit assignment)**

- 1. What does GHG stand for? How do humans produce GHGs?
- 2. Define Climate Change. How do humans contribute to climate change?
- 3. How do Canadians contribute to climate change? (consider gross and per capita emissions).
- 4. Despite the known problems with fossil fuels, countries have struggled to reduce their emissions. Why is it difficult to stop using fossil fuels? *Consider your own lifestyle*.
- 5. What are the impacts of climate change on the Canada's biodiversity and environment? (*Discuss 3*)
- 6. What are the impacts of climate change on the Canada's economy and health? (Discuss 3)
- 7. What is mitigation? How can we mitigate climate change?
- 8. What is adaptation? How can we adapt to climate change?
- 9. What strategies could we use in our community to mitigate climate change?
- 10. In your opinion, is Canada's carbon tax an effective mitigation policy? If not, suggest an alternative policy! (Please support your answer with sources).
