
Migration and Actual Change Assignment

- 1. Define the terms migration, immigration, emigration (3 pts)
- 2. How does the terms In-migration and Out-migration differ? (2 pts)
- 3. Between 1991 and 1994, 1 592 000 people were born in Canada and 805 000 died. In the same period, 996 000 people immigrated into the country and 177 000 people emigrated. Calculate the following...
 - a. Natural Change (difference between births and deaths)
 - b. Net Migration (difference between immigration and emigration)
 - c. Actual Change (total population change)
- 4. Countries always have positive and negative conditions that affect migration. Explain this phenomenon with reference to the diagram below. Use the terms *push factors*, *pull factors*, *repel factors*, and *intervening obstacles* and give examples of each. (8pts)
